Berlin and Chamonix

Tuesday February 2- Sunday February 14

Chamonix is a famous resort in the French Alps at the foot of Mont Blanc. It is quite fabulous, though perhaps not quite as glamorous as last year's St Moritz (Sorry, Team Chicas).

Chamonix was host to the First Winter Olympic games in 1924. It is not a ski in - ski out purpose built resort, but rather a town which became the world capital of mountaineering and developed into a world renowned ski resort. It is actually 5 ski resorts and one famous off piste lift access (the Aiguille du Midi).

We will be staying at Hotel Morgane which is a four star hotel. As in past years, this is a half pension European plan which includes breakfast and dinner. Le Bistro, the hotel's restaurant is a one star Michelin restaurant, so it is sure to please the foodies in the group. Wine is included with dinner.

Our side trip will be to Berlin. As Germany's capital, the city has undergone enormous changes in the past 100 years. No longer divided, this city is now a thriving, modern and exciting destination, welcoming tourists and business visitors alike. Since World War II, the city has emerged from the past and undergone the biggest construction project in Europe.



When the Berlin Wall was destroyed in 1989 this was an enormous turning point for the city, which has previously been divided for over 28 years. East and West are now thoroughly unified, although there are still some signs of division in these areas. There are countless landmarks throughout the city and popular sights include the Berliner Dom - a huge domed cathedral standing within the Mitte borough; the Brandenburg Gate - the former city gate and now an iconic symbol of Germany; the Potsdamer

Platz - one of the busiest squares in Europe, full of shops, bars, cafés and places of entertainment, Checkpoint Charlie - probably the most famous part of the old Berlin Wall; and the imposing Reichstag, home to the German parliament and just as impressive today as when it was completed in 1884.

Our hotel, Berlin Hilton, a five star hotel, is a beautiful hotel just minutes away from Brandenburg Gate.

Berlin is an extremely diverse city, residents and travelers of all nationalities visit and live here. The population in Berlin is approximately 3.5 million and is expected to continue to grow. Surprisingly this city is extremely liberal as 1 in 10 inhabitants are gay or bisexual, which makes this awesome city one of Europe's top 3 gay cities. Because of the tolerance of the Berlin people you will easily find many same sex couples walking hand in hand and kissing along the gorgeous city streets. This is definitely a must visit city for the rising gay traveler

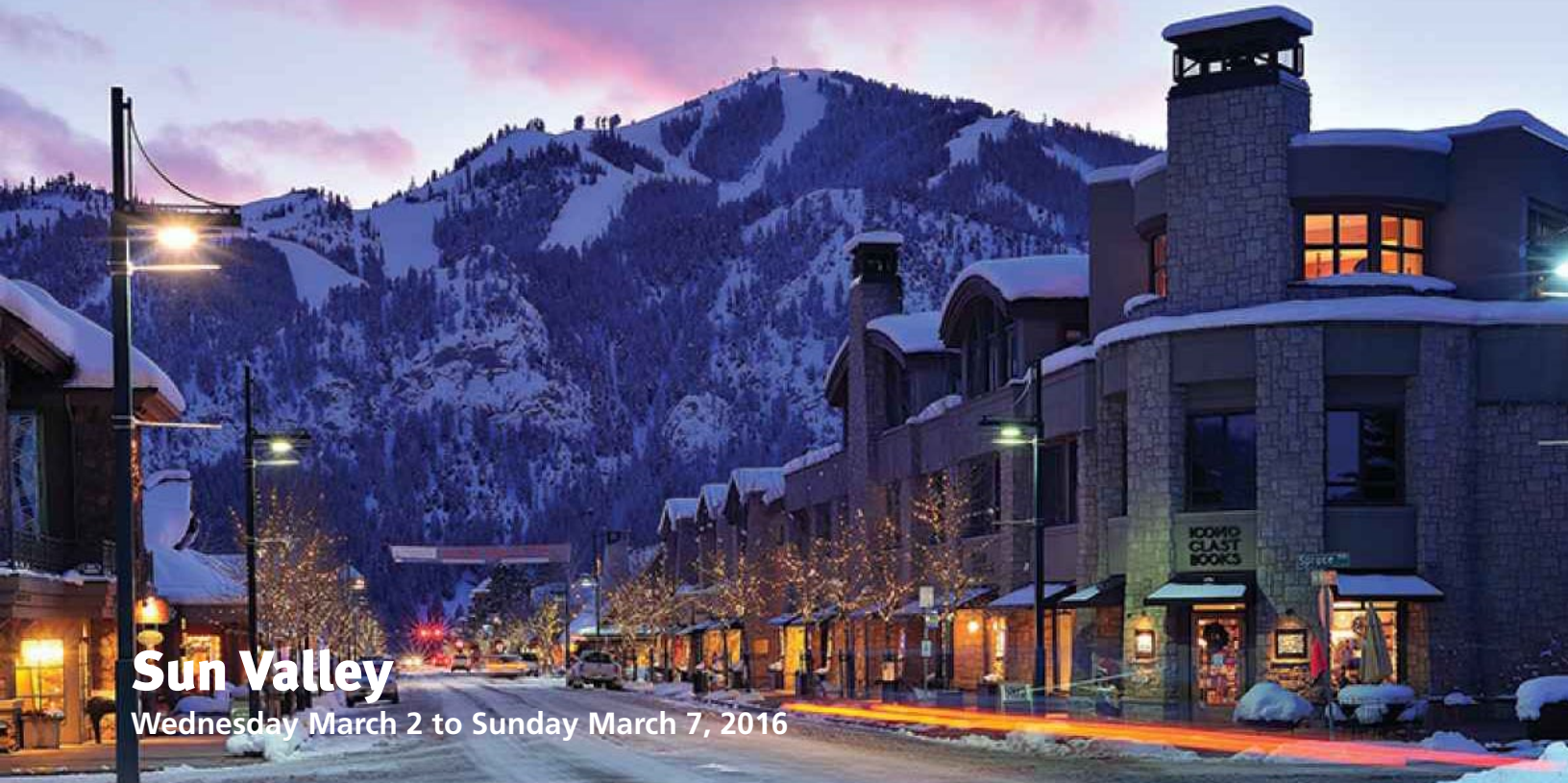

Whistler is western Canada's coolest, swankiest, and gay-friendliest ski town. It is one of North America's best gay winter hideaways, a modern and stylish community rife with gay-friendly hotels, boutiques, and restaurants, all just steps from one of the world's biggest - and most exciting - ski resorts, **Whistler Blackcomb**. In fact, there's as much to do here for non-skiers as for fans of boarding and skiing - during the annual **Winter Pride and Ski Festival**, there's everything from cooking classes and blow-out parties to Ziptrek ecotours and dog-sledding.

Due to Gay Ski Week and Florida Ski Council conference we have been unable to have properties hold units/ rooms reservations for us without a substantial nonrefundable deposit. There is availability, but we must have an exact number confirmed and put down a deposit right away at the time of reservation. Therefore, we will need an exact number prior to the Early Bird deadline of October 17 of those who are seriously considering going to Whistler. The Out of State chair, Moises Cruz, will then work with the travel agent(s) and put together a package in the next couple of days which will be emailed to all those interested with the exact cost. He would then ask for a final confirmation and then proceed to book the package.

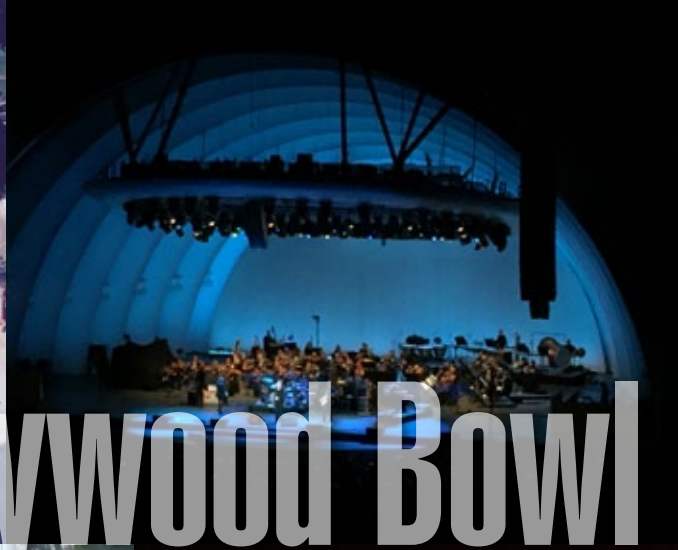
At this point, for the 7-night option, we're looking at \$1300-\$1600 for air, transfers, and lodging, and for the 4-night option \$1000-\$1300 per person based on double occupancy, with a single supplement of \$500-\$700.

Trip Cancellation and Wait List Policies

Mammoth Trips:

To secure your space on a Mammoth trip, full payment is due at the time of sign-up. If you cancel prior to 30 days before the beginning of the trip, a \$50 cancellation fee will be charged. If you cancel less than 30 days from the departure date of the trip, then there will be NO refund unless the space is re-sold, in which case a \$50 cancellation fee will be charged.

We maintain a waiting list for all Mammoth trips. Members are not allowed to transfer or trade their spaces with anyone else. If you cannot make a trip, you need to cancel your spot. If the trip is sold-out, the next person on the waiting list will be offered the space.

The Arriba! Board of Directors has the sole discretion on any refunds.

Out of State Trips

A trip deposit is required at the time of sign-up to secure your space. Deposit amount are determined by the Arriba! Board based on early security deposits we are required to pay to the trip vendors for transportation and lodging. If minimum quotas to maintain the group rates do not look like they will be met, individual trips may be cancelled at no cost to the participant. If this occurs your deposit will be fully refunded.

In all other cases the following policies apply unless otherwise stated at the time the trip is offered:

General Cancellation Penalty Charges:

- 90 days or greater prior to departure date: \$50 per person
- 31 to 90 days prior to departure: \$250 per person plus any vendor penalty fees (airline name changes, reduction of guaranteed hotel space, etc.), If your space is re-sold – then assessed at \$50 per person plus any vendor change penalty fees.
- Less than 30 days prior to departure: No Refund unless your space is re-sold and then is assessed at \$50 per person plus any vendor change penalty fees. The Board reserves the right to determine the refund amount, if any.

I agree to be bound by the Club's trip cancellation and waitlist policies and payment requirements as stated in the individual trip descriptions. I have read and accept all conditions above. My signature indicates acceptance of the Waiver and Release of All Liability.
