The Santa Barbara Wine trip returns

We are pleased to announce the return another fun and fabulous Santa Barbara Wine Tasting Trip on **Saturday, August 17**. We are taking sign ups now!! The trip is limited to 20 people, so don't delay signing up in order to reserve a spot. This event is also open to non-members.

We will take Amtrak, departing from Union Station at 7:50 am arriving in Santa Barbara at approximately 10:20 am. Our private group tour will begin there with a pick up from our host and driver where over the course of the day we will visit 4 wineries (TBA) and a gourmet lunch will be provided. We will be dropped off at the Santa Barbara train station at approximately 5:30-6 pm where we can walk a short distance into town for dinner or shopping (or more wine!) prior to catching the last train out of Santa Barbara at 6:58 pm. We arrive in LA at 9:45 pm.

The cost of the trip is \$205 per person and includes the Amtrak train ride, bus tour to four wineries , and lunch. We are also providing a bus tour only option for \$145 if you want to catch the train from another location and buy your own Amtrak ticket. Keep in mind that you must be on the same train that arrives in Santa Barbara at 10:20 am (or arrives at Santa Barbara at an earlier time).

To sign up, e-mail your social chair, Pam Shade at social@arribaski.org to see if space is available. Once you receive confirmation that space is available, mail in a check to the Arriba P.O. Box (P.O. Box 69611, West Hollywood, CA, 90069). Payment must be received within three days of confirmation or you will lose your space! **The last day to sign up is July 20**. Sign up now because this has been a very popular trip and will likely fill up before the deadline.

Trip Cancellation and Wait List Policies

Mammoth Trips:

To secure your space on a Mammoth trip, full payment is due at the time of sign-up. If you cancel prior to 30 days before the beginning of the trip, a \$50 cancellation fee will be charged. If you cancel less than 30 days from the departure date of the trip, then there will be NO refund unless the space is re-sold, in which case a \$50 cancellation fee will be charged.

We maintain a waiting list for all Mammoth trips. Members are not allowed to transfer or trade their spaces with anyone else. If you cannot make a trip, you need to cancel your spot. If the trip is sold-out, the next person on the waiting list will be offered the space.

The Arriba! Board of Directors has the sole discretion on any refunds.

Out of State Trips

A trip deposit is required at the time of sign-up to secure your space. Deposit amount are determined by the Arriba! Board based on early security deposits we are required to pay to the trip vendors for transportation and lodging. If minimum quotas to maintain the group rates do not look like they will be met, individual trips may be cancelled at no cost to the participant. If this occurs your deposit will be fully refunded.

In all other cases the following policies apply unless otherwise stated at the time the trip is offered:

General Cancellation Penalty Charges:

- 90 days or greater prior to departure date: \$50 per person
- 31 to 90 days prior to departure: \$250 per person plus any vendor penalty fees (airline name changes, reduction of guaranteed hotel space, etc.), If your space is re-sold – then assessed at \$50 per person plus any vendor change penalty fees.
- Less than 30 days prior to departure: No Refund unless your space is re-sold and then is assessed at \$50 per person plus any vendor change penalty fees. The Board reserves the right to determine the refund amount, if any.
